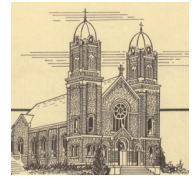

Father Swamy's Message

BAPTISED INTO OUR ORDINARINESS:

Reflecting on the Baptism of the Lord, Bishop Fulton J. Sheen (Life of Christ) observed that a person received Baptism to be freed from the stain of sin; but the Son of Man had no sin, yet received baptism as an act of identifying with the sinful humanity. How great an act of humility and self-emptying! Jesus' Baptism reminds us three important lessons.

First, the baptism of Jesus reminds us of our identity. It reminds us of who we are and Whose we are. By Baptism we become sons and daughters of God, brothers and sisters of Jesus, members of his Church, heirs of Heaven, and temples of the Holy Spirit.

Second, Jesus' baptism reminds us also of our mission: a) to experience the presence of God within us, to acknowledge our own dignity as God's children, and to appreciate the Divine Presence in others by honoring them, loving them and serving them in all humility; b) to live as the children of God in thought, word and action. c) to lead holy and transparent Christian lives and not to desecrate our bodies, by impurity, injustice, intolerance, jealousy, or hatred; d) to accept both the good and the bad experiences of life as the gifts of a loving Heavenly Father for our growth in holiness; e) and to grow daily in intimacy with God by spiritual and corporal acts of mercy.

And, third, It is a day to thank God for the graces, we have received in Baptism, to renew our Baptismal promises and to preach Christ's "Good News" by our transparent Christian lives.
