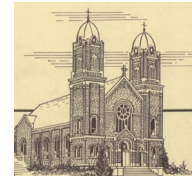

Rev Ratna Swamy Nannam, MSFS, will become Parochial Administrator of Holy Family (Alma) and Sacred Heart Parish (Paxico) and Chaplain of Washburn University Catholic Campus Center (Topeka), on August 1, 2021. **This note, in way of introducing himself, is from Fr. Swamy:**

BE JOYFUL IN HOPE, PATIENT IN AFFLICTION AND FAITHFUL IN PRAYER". Romans 12:12

I have been a priest for 14 years, with the Religious Community - Missionaries of St. Francis de Sales (MSFS). I am a native of India and grew up with a traditional Catholic family on a rural farm. For 14 years my parents were unable to have children. They had a special devotion to St. Anthony of Padua and prayed for his intercession to God for a child. God answered their prayers and I was miraculously born on January 12, 1978. My mother often reminded me about her prayer to have a child - that is: "God bless me with a child and I will offer him to your service". I have one younger sister and one younger brother. My beloved father passed away on April 8, 2019.

My home parish is served by the missionaries (MSFS) and beginning of my 5th-grade year, I boarded and studied in the Catholic School. I was trained as a Sacristan - cleaning the Church and setting up for the liturgy. I was a regular Mass server and sang in the liturgy. The missionaries' exemplary life in the parish and School attracted me to devote my life in prayer and human values. I was greatly influenced during my Schooling and in June 1995, following my 10th-grade year, I joined the Seminary.

After completing 12 years of Seminary training in India, I was Ordained a Priest on February 10, 2007. I served as the School Administrator for four years and as the Pastor for seven years in the mission parishes back in India.

On August 8, 2018, I was sent by my Religious Community Superiors to serve in the Archdiocese of Kansas City in Kansas. I served at St. Joseph's, Olpe and St. Mary's, Hartford till June 2019, and Most Pure Heart of Mary Church, Topeka till July 2021. I am very excited to be with you here and serve you in Sacred Heart of Jesus Church - Paxico, Holy Family - Alma and Holy Spirit Catholic Center - Washburn University.
