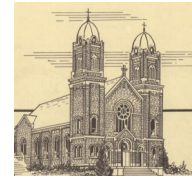

**New Covid Guidelines...** As our County has lifted many of the Covid restrictions, and the Archdiocese has advised us to follow our local County regulations, we will be relaxing a lot of our restrictions. **Masks are recommended but not required now.** At Sacred Heart, the small side pews will still have every other pew roped off, for those either not vaccinated or those still concerned. The rest of the church will be open. At Holy Family, the front half of the North side will still have socially distanced pews, the rest of the church will be open, and the hall will still be available for overflow.

**No Mass changes...** For now, we will continue with every other week Sunday Masses. Hopefully this can change by June, when the dispensation to attend Mass will most likely be lifted. This, of course, is not set in stone yet, as Fr. Earl will not be able to help in the near future (keep him in your prayers), but we do want to offer Hope that we will soon be back to near normal! Please say a prayer for all priests, as they are asked to do more and more! The restrictions to only attend Mass in your home parish has been lifted.
