We have been asked if it would be possible for us to send him and his unit some needed and useful things. The Altar Society has accepted this wonderful opportunity to help our beloved soldiers. Here is a list of ideas of things that would be enjoyed and helpful: **Baby wipes to be used as toilet paper; energy drinks; drink mix packets such as Crystal Light and Gatorade; healthy snacks like jerky and trail mix; Nutella; magazines; anything home-made or baked that can survive the 3-4 month shipment** There are no female soldiers in his unit, so nothing explicitly for women is needed. Also, there is no accessible microwave, so nothing that needs to be microwaved should be sent. **A friendly reminder that we are beginning a new ministry to support our own Douglas Darnall-Austin and his unit with useful and needed items. We are going to send a box a month, each circle group in order beginning with group 1. Please bring your items to the back of the church as soon as possible. Thank you!!**
