Eight hundred years ago, a young Italian man searching for meaning in his life went into a dilapidated old church and heard the voice of God speak to him: "Rebuild my Church. As you can see, it is in ruins." If you and I listen carefully, I believe we will hear the same voice saying the same thing in our hearts today.

Everything in life requires courage. Whether it is playing or coaching football, crossing the room to ask a girl out on a date or rekindling a love that has grown cold, starting a new business, battling a potentially fatal disease, getting married, struggling to overcome an addiction, or coming humbly before your God in prayer, life requires courage. Courage is essential to the human experience. It animates us, brings us to life, and makes everything else possible. And yet, courage is the rarest quality in a human person. Marriage Minute...Can you say, "Politically Incorrect?" Does St. Paul really want wives to be "submissive to their husbands?" Let's take a look at the true meaning of this phrase. "Submissive" means to be "under the mission of," and St. Paul tells husbands that their mission is to "love their wives as Christ loved the Church." Considering that Christ loved the Church by laying his life down for her, this is a mission most wives can get behind when we understand it outside of today's politically-charged climate. To be mutually submissive simply means that both spouses put the good of their marriage ahead of themselves.
