Marriage Minute...Solitary Confinement When things are difficult in our marriage, we can often isolate ourselves. We can feel like the lepers in this weekend's readings, waiting for rejection from others we think will consider us "unclean." This is reinforced when we see others who seem to have minimal problems. Like the lepers, the problems themselves seem so much bigger when faced alone. When Jesus healed the lepers, he not only ended their physical suffering, but invited them back into community.
