Pentecost... is the solemnity on which we commemorate the coming of the Holy Spirit on the early followers of Jesus.

Symbols of the season—*Tongues of fire* appear to hover over the disciples on Pentecost—a sign of the Lord's presence and power. In the Old Testament, fire was often a sign of God's presence and holiness, which might purify or punish. *Red*, the liturgical color for Pentecost Day, reminds us of the offering of life—lives of Christian martyrs gone before us and of our own lives poured out in the service of Christ. *The Holy Spirit* is represented in Scripture in various ways—as a peaceful dove, as life-giving breath or invisible wind, or as visible fire that transforms what it touches. Throughout Scripture, the Spirit is the Lord's gift to his people to give life, faith and understanding.
