Lenten Mission "The Mass and the Eucharist" ...The first century Jewish historian Josephus records that, on Passover in the year 70 AD the priests offered more than a quarter of a million lambs on the Temple's altar, 256,500 to be precise. Jesus offers Himself once as the perfect offering for our sins. How does this relate to the Mass and the Eucharist? Plan to attend a Lenten Mission at the Holy Family Church Hall on the Wednesdays of Lent from 7-8pm. The Wednesday missions will start on March 13th and run through lent culminating with a Seder Meal on Wednesday of Holy Week. All are welcome.

The Season Lent-A journey to Holiness...Each year when we start thinking about Lent, we often seem initially drawn to the concepts of sacrifice and self-denial. These issues are significant, but they are neither the starting point nor the end of the season. The goal of Lent, in fact, is quite the opposite. Lent is first and foremost a time, not for diminishment, but for growth and development. We should aspire to expand our hearts, enlarge our souls, and enrich our minds. Perhaps the meaning of the Lord's words is this—God prefers a full heart to an empty stomach. *Go and learn the meaning of the words, "I desire mercy, not sacrifice."*—Matthew 9:13
