Because our marriages imitate Christ's love for the Church, we are called to generously listen to our spouse. How do we do this? • Be available: prioritize listening to your spouse by setting aside time each day to connect. • Be attentive: When listening, give full attention through proper posture and eye contact. And shut off distractions like the phone or television. • Be understanding: demonstrate you understood what was said by repeating back in your own words what was communicated to you. • Be prayerful: ask God to help you be a better listener.
