Marriage Minute...Famous Last Words Before ascending into heaven, Jesus told his disciples to "Go out into all the world and tell the Good News." As married couples, we have a very specific piece of good news to proclaim: that lifelong love is possible! In our current culture, this is a message that young people desperately need to hear. Since married love is meant to image Christ's love for the Church, our message is the very heart of the Gospel!
