The Miracle of Life... *We are following the conception of Christ (or a baby named Chris) and the pregnancy of Mary (or any mother in our society)! This is week 28 since conception.*

"I'm going to be in my first Life Chain today. The cars may not notice me but my mom will. Not much room to wave in here. I'm moving around quite a bit. Whoa! I'm having a little trouble with my balance, but it is getting better. You could hear my heartbeat if you put your ear on my mother's tummy. My eyes are opening so I will practice blinking." Mom's talking about different names for me. How about Chris? *"Come, let us sing joyfully to the Lord; let us acclaim the Rock of our salvation."* Psalm 95:1

Marriage Minute... "Complete my joy by being of the same mind, with the same love, united in heart, thinking one thing." This sounds great until your spouse attempts to load the dishwasher and does it wrong, or dresses your toddler in clashing patterns for Mass!
