The Miracle of Life...*We are following the conception of Christ (or a baby named Chris) and the pregnancy of Mary (or any mother in our society)! This is week 33 since conception.*

Chris weighs over three pounds and may weigh about seven pounds at birth. "My brain is growing very fast. I'm starting to have regular sleep and awake time I have dreams but I keep them secret between God and me. I'm using my four senses of vision, hearing, taste and touch. I try to stretch out but there is not room. Mom's friends are planning a baby shower, I don't know why, it's already wet in here." *"Listen to my words: When a prophet of the LORD is among you, I reveal myself to him in visions, I speak to him in dreams."* Numbers 12:5-7

Marriage Minute...Do you have unrealistic expectations about what marriage is supposed to be like? Of course we have a right to expect certain things from our spouse, such as time, attention, affection and help. But we can get into trouble when we expect things that aren't reasonable. For instance: • You expect that he can fix things (because your dad did). • You expect her to keep the house as clean as she did before you had 3 kids. • You expect your spouse to react the way that you would, even though he is a totally unique person!
